



## **Wakulla County Florida March 31 9:00AM – 12:00PM**

In the aftermath of hurricanes the county's churches, organizations, clubs and agencies have a history of stepping forward to assist with the recovery efforts of individuals and families.

In an effort to enhance the teamwork and capabilities of the county's community, civic and faith based organizations as well as local and regional governmental agencies to provide vital disaster recovery services, the Wakulla County Sheriff's Office Emergency Management Division has undertaken the coordination of an innovative disaster learning experience entitled "Hurricane Faith – A Storm Recovery Tabletop Exercise".

During this exercise area local churches and non-governmental organizations along with governmental agencies will be simulating the activities associated with Wakulla County's recovery from a category two hurricane.

The purpose of this exercise is to evaluate and enhance the ability of various faith, civic and community based organizations along with governmental agencies as they work together in a coordinated effort to meet the disaster recovery needs of the county's residents who have sustained personal loss due to Hurricane Faith.

With the mission of better preparing Wakulla County for future disasters, the Sheriff's Office asks that local churches, clubs, organizations, departments and agencies give their support to this important learning opportunity by registering to participate in the Hurricane Faith Tabletop Exercise today.
