Exercise Directive

The members of the Gulf County Board of County Commissioners recognize the significance of disaster planning and the value that exercises have on the county's capability to deliver critical services to the residents Gulf County.

In an effort to prepare local and regional governmental disaster recovery agencies along with community and faith based organizations that provide vital disaster recovery operations, the county's Emergency Management Department has undertaken the coordination of a innovative disaster learning experience entitled "Hurricane Resurgence – A Storm Recovery Tabletop Exercise".

During this exercise governmental disaster recovery and housing agencies, area churches as well as local and regional non-governmental organizations will be simulating the activities associated with Gulf County's recovery from a category two hurricane.

The purpose of this exercise is to evaluate and enhance the ability of various agencies, departments and organizations as they work together in a coordinated effort to meet the recovery and housing needs of the county's residents who have sustained personal loss due to Hurricane Resurgence.

With this directive, the Gulf County Board of County Commissioners directs all county agencies to give their support to this vital disaster exercise and encourage the county's citizens to become better prepared for hurricanes and other disasters that threaten us and our families on a daily basis.
