**WHEREAS**, the Task Force has completed the hazard assessment and has identified numerous initiatives designed to reduce the impact of future disasters; and

**WHEREAS**, the Task Force has incorporated their findings and recommendations into the Gulf County Local Mitigation Strategy; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board is committed to reducing the impact of hazards for all county residents; and

**WHEREAS**, the Gulf County Local Mitigation Strategy supports hazard mitigation actions throughout the entire county.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, this 8<sup>th</sup> Day of September, 2009, the Board adopts the Gulf County Local Mitigation Strategy to reflect the current need and citizen desire to identify and implement hazard mitigation initiatives that will reduce the county's susceptibility to numerous hazards. And, at the appropriate time, the Board will develop and submit funding proposals to the appropriate agencies to implement the hazard mitigation initiatives identified in the Gulf County Local Mitigation Strategy.
