

RESOLUTION 11-19
BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
JACKSON COUNTY

WHEREAS, the Jackson County Board of County Commissioners created a Local Mitigation Strategy Task Force comprised of county and municipal representatives, private citizens, local and regional agencies involved in hazard mitigation activities, and agencies having authority to regulate development including businesses and other private and non-profit interests; and

WHEREAS, the Board charged the Task Force with the responsibility to assess the hazards facing the county and to identify initiatives designed to reduce the impact of those hazards; and

WHEREAS, the Task Force has completed the hazard assessment and has identified numerous initiatives designed to reduce the impact of future disasters; and

WHEREAS, the Task Force has incorporated their findings and recommendations into the Jackson County Local Mitigation Strategy; and

WHEREAS, the Board is committed to reducing the impact of hazards for all county residents; and

WHEREAS, the Jackson County Local Mitigation Strategy supports hazard mitigation actions throughout the entire county.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Board adopts the 2011 Jackson County Local Mitigation Strategy to reflect the current need and citizen desire to identify and implement hazard mitigation initiatives that will reduce the county's susceptibility to numerous hazards. And, at the appropriate time, the Board will develop and submit funding proposals to the appropriate agencies to implement the hazard mitigation initiatives identified in the 2011 Jackson County Local Mitigation Strategy.
